

## A Message From Father Walter

**SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT** 

In Mark's story of the transfiguration, Peter does not know what to say or how to react to the incredible scene he has witnessed. All he can offer is the weak suggestion of setting up three booths or shrines to commemorate the event (similar to the custom of building such structures as part of the Jewish feast of Tabernacles of Booths). But the transfigured Christ asks more of us than memorials of wood and stone, brick and mortar. He seeks to be a living presence that illuminates human hearts and transforms human history. He asks those who follow him to mirror that presence in their own lives of "transfiguring" despair into hope, sadness into joy, anguish into healing, estrangement into community.
